

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE FIVE COUNTY ASSOCIATION OF GOVERNMENTS NATURAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN FIVE YEAR PLAN UPDATE

Whereas, Hurricane City, Utah recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property; and

Whereas, undertaking hazard mitigation actions before disasters occur will reduce the potential for harm to people and property and save taxpayer dollars; and

Whereas, an adopted natural hazard mitigation plan is required as a condition of future grant funding of mitigation projects; and

WHEREAS, the Five County Association of Governments was contracted by the State of Utah to complete a five-year update of the Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan which was completed in 2004 by the Association and adopted by every municipality and county in the Five County region; and

Whereas, Hurricane City, Utah formally participated in a planning process along with every town, city and county in the Five County Association of Governments region of Utah to prepare an update to the previously completed Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan;

WHEREAS, the Plan identifies likely hazards, analysis risks and potential losses and identifies possible mitigation measures to limit losses; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it would be in the best interest of the community as a whole to adopt the Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan, Five Year Plan Update, as it pertains to the City; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HURRICANE, UTAH THAT: Hurricane City hereby adopts the Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan, Five Year Plan Update for the Five County region.

This Resolution shall be effective upon adoption.
