

RESOLUTION NO. 2011-10-002R

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE FIVE COUNTY ASSOCIATION OF GOVERNMENTS
NATURAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN FIVE-YEAR PLAN UPDATE**

WHEREAS, the City of St. George, Utah, recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property; and

WHEREAS, undertaking hazard mitigation actions before disasters occur will reduce the potential for harm to people and property and save taxpayer dollars; and

WHEREAS, an adopted natural hazard mitigation plan is required as a condition of future grant funding of mitigation projects; and

WHEREAS, the Five County Association of Governments ("Association"), was contracted by the State of Utah to complete the initial five-year Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan (the "Plan") for the period of 2004 to 2009; and

WHEREAS, the State of Utah has re-contracted with the Association to complete a five-year update of the Plan for the period of 2010 to 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Plan completed in 2004 by the Association was adopted by every municipality and county within the Association's region; and

WHEREAS, the City of St. George, Utah, formally participated in a planning process along with every town, city and county within the Association's region to prepare an update to the previously completed Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan;

WHEREAS, the Plan and its Five-Year Plan Update identifies likely hazards, analyzes risks and potential losses and identifies possible mitigation measures to limit losses; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it would be in the best interest of the community as a whole to adopt the Five-Year Plan Update, as it pertains to the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of St. George that the City of St. George, Utah hereby adopts the Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan, Five-Year Plan Update for the Five County region.
